Ethics classes will be available at Warrawee Public School from Wednesday 27th February as an alternative to non-scripture.

The NSW government has authorised Primary Ethics, a not-for profit organisation, to design curriculum and deliver these classes. Classes are inquiry based and children use dialogue and discussion to learn how to think about ethical matters through the give-and-take of reasoned argument.

The class size is limited to 22 pupils so in the event of over-enrolment, the first 22 forms received for each class will be offered a place. **The enrolments from last year do not roll over to this year. Everyone interested will need to re-enrol each year**.
