During Term 3, Year 4 students will be involved in an exciting conservation program with the Turramurra Learning Community of Schools. This involves Turramurra High School, as well as the four feeder primary schools from this area, including Warrawee PS. This program uses a project-based learning approach enabling the students to explore the real world challenge of protecting a species that is found in the local environment. This year all schools will be exploring the Eastern Pygmy Possum.

Venue:	Gibberagong Environmental Education Centre, Ku-ring-gai Chase National Park, Bobbin Head		
Travel Arrangements:	Bus from school to venue and return

Cost:	The cost for participation in the program is \$80 which covers buses, photography, expert presenters, resources and incidental costs as the students gain expertise in exploring and presenting their products.

Description of Event/Excursion:	While this project will be facilitated by class teachers, in-depth learning experiences will be delivered by a number of professional educators including staff from Gibberagong Environmental Education Centre. Further to this expert assistance, high school mentor students from Turramurra High School will provide additional leadership and guidance to the Year 4 students' learning during the program.		
	As part of this project, Year 4 students will be visiting Gibberagong on Tuesday the 4 th of August, 2020 (Term 3 - Week 3) for the Launch Day.		
	In addition, students will have an incursion, on Tuesday the 18 th August, 2020 (Term 3 - Week 5), where experts who come in will facilitate student learning through a range of practical, hands-on and in depth learning sessions. Within school hours, students design a prototype to solve a real world problem with the Eastern Pygmy Possum		
	These products will be exhibited at an expo at a time and format to be advised.		
	This is a very engaging and exciting program where students will create and exhibit their newly acquired knowledge and skills, with the ultimate aim of educating the community about local biodiversity issues.
