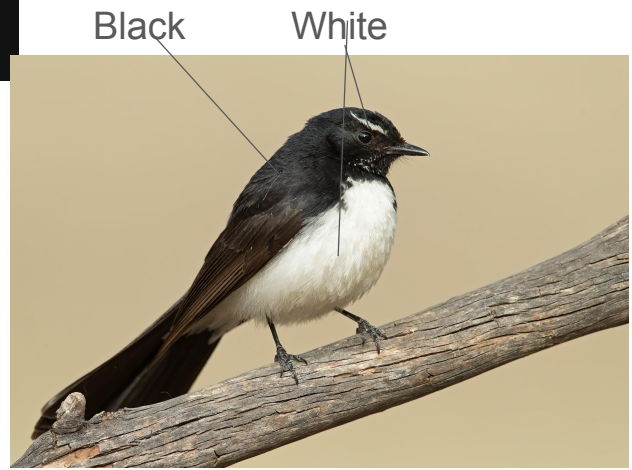


Did You Know?

Average weight:20g

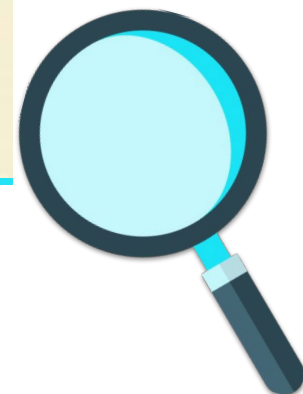
