Section 1: Wellbeing of staff, students, visitors and others

Requirement	Measures to be implemented
People attending the venues should be feeling well and do not have any respiratory or COVID-19 symptoms	ALL attending staff instructed to notify schools if showing any signs of covid symptoms and not attend the event. All students to be advised that if unwell they should not be participating in inter-school events.
Exclude staff and visitors who are unwell	Individual schools are responsible for ensuring that their staff and visitors have understood that they should not be present if unwell.
Make sure department staff are provided with information, training and instructions on the DoE COVID-19 response	All attending staff are to ensure that they have signed in at their respective schools prior to coaching the various sports.
Consider arrangements to enable those who are vulnerable to COVID-19 to participate where relevant	All staff and students provided with hand sanitizer and should at all times adhere to 1.5m physical distancing guideline when not playing or umpiring.
Make sure service providers, external consultants, contractors, etc. have a COVID-19 safety plan	All cricket, softball and t'ball games are to be run by DoE staff. Service providers used for league tag must provide their safety plan to the convener. This should be scanned and kept as a record on the shared Google Drive.

Section 2: Physical distancing

Requirement	Measures to be implemented
Attendance	All teams should have their names marked off before leaving school to compete.
Promote and practise physical distancing	Each school should monitor their own school safe physical distancing. Visiting parents should be advised by the individual schools that it is expected that physical distancing is required at all grounds.

Requirement	Measures to be implemented
Ensure areas are of sufficient size to accommodate the number of people in attendance	All individual school areas allocate designated areas which cater for safe physical distancing. Attending staff and student numbers to comply with current venue capacity restrictions.
Consider ways to minimise co-mingling between groups of people	Students seated in designated school area when not competing, no mingling after games, no body contact in celebration to occur following games. Parents are recommended to physically distance themselves by 2m unless in the same household.
Reduce crowding where possible and promote physical distancing (at entrance, sign-in areas, egress points, waiting areas, etc.)	Schools will wait in a designated area before beginning their games.
Where food is consumed	Students if instructed should only eat in their designated areas.
Where event or activity includes singing or drama performances	n/a
Where event or activity includes sport or physical activity	Once the games are finished participants should return to own school areas to reduce mingling.
Where event or activity includes professional learning, training, external facilitators etc	Facilitators in league tag will endeavour to physically distance themselves where possible and after the games move from the venue.

Section 3: Cleaning and hygiene

Requirement	Measures to be implemented
Adopt good hygiene practices	Bottles of sanitizer to be provided by individual schools for their own students.
Cleaning protocols for shared items including equipment and tools	Schools to use their own equipment which is used in their games etc bats, helmets etc. Students should sanitise their hands on completion of games.
Food and drink	Students do not share food or drink.

Requirement	Measures to be implemented
Cleaning and hygiene of facilities	Council is responsible for the cleaning of each venue.
Ensure bathrooms are well stocked with hand soap and paper towels or hand dryers	Each individual council is responsible for the cleanliness of the toilets. Teachers should check the cleanliness on arrival and the convener phone Council if unacceptable. Hornsby Zone has exclusive use of most facilities during competition times on Friday mornings.

Section 4: Record keeping

Requirement	Measures to be implemented
Keep a record of participants	Each individual school keeps a record of who has attended the games. Team rolls should be kept.
Keep a copy of the COVID-19 safety plan	Store the COVID-19 safety plan on the Hornsby Zone shared Google Drive.
